



The National Young Leaders Days (NYLD) Covid Safety Event Policy

Updated 22 April, 2022

This policy has been created according to the guidelines set out in the Covid-19 Protection Framework (CPF). This document sits alongside the NYLD Health and Safety documents which will be available from the [EVENTS](#) page of our website, one month beforehand (search under your particular event).

NYLD is classed as an 'event' under the CPF and will operate in person under the Orange or Green settings.

In all our Covid event planning we will work closely with our venues to ensure all safety measures are in place. If you have a question about a specific venue, please contact us.

Record keeping/scanning

In accordance with the changes to the Orange light settings which come into effect from 11:59am on Friday 25 March, there is no requirement to scan in or for a business to display a QR code poster or have mandatory record keeping.

Face masks

Under the Orange setting you do not need to wear a face mask either indoors or outdoors if you are attending a gathering or event. If you would choose to wear one then you should absolutely feel comfortable doing so.

Workers and volunteers at indoor events must wear face masks — unless they are exempt. NYLD staff will be wearing facemasks while working and interacting with students.

If any students wish to interact with NYLD speakers outside of their presentation on stage ie: at the signing table at the end of the day, then the students will need to be wearing a mask, unless they are exempt.

My Vaccine Pass

There will be no vaccine passes used at the 2022 NYLD events.

Other Covid-19 Health Measures

- Hand Sanitiser will be onsite at entry points and other high traffic locations around the venue.
- If you feel unwell or have symptoms of Covid-19 we ask you do not come along to the live event.
